8. Old Business

- a. Options for updating Bylaws/ Operating Procedures: Two evenings of 3 hours or one full day of 6 hours on a weekend and get it all done at once. Being done together with an ASCA rep. Might use our grant money for this. We could also do one set of bylaws this year (council) and PAA next year. Discussion about doing two 3 hour evenings rather than a full 6 hour day. Not sure if we'll do this this year or next year.
- b. Funding paperwork has been submitted to the city for grad. They are giving us \$2500. We used to get more but it has dwindled over the years. We had about 340 grads last year. This year it will be about 380.

9. New Business

- a. Casino update - Volunteer sign up is live. 14 of 15 spots are full. We still need 1 more volunteer. Sean will send out the sign-up link again so we can get that last spot filled. License has been approved.
- b. Teacher Wishlist:
 - CAWLS Dog - \$250. Erin motioned that we approve funding for \$250 for the CAWLS dog, Stephanie seconded the motion. Motion passed.
 - Update: CAWLS dog going very well. Kids love it; PAA has not yet paid.
 - 3 New Sewing machines - \$1099.35. Erin motioned that we approve funding for the 3 new sewing machines, up to \$1100. Stephanie seconded. Motion passed.
 - Update: Purchased but PAA have not paid yet.
 - USB Bridge and iPad air to utilize the Heart Rate monitors that were gifted - \$1480. Sabrina motioned that we approve funding up to \$1200 for these items. Erin seconded it. Motion passed.
 - Update: Purchased but PAA have not paid yet.
 - Funding to sponsor Indigenous Dancers for June - \$1500 (We had approved her for \$1000 last year that didn't get used). We will discuss this at a later date.
 - Update: Nothing to update- further discussion at a later meeting.

New Requests- Deferred

- Smart carts and track for Science 10. Asking for \$1700 total.
- Folding tables and cart (for final exams). We are currently borrowing from other schools. Asking for \$3150.
- Matilda the Musical is asking for either \$4000 for techs to teach students the technical side of production. \$8000 would cover all set costs.
- Kiln for the art department. Old one is broken and can't be fixed. \$6945.75 for a new kiln.
- Poster printer to create school materials (monthly calendars, ads for sports and cultural events) and school work rather than doing printing elsewhere. Asking for \$5500.

- c. Graduates only Helping Hands Awards- Awards that are not academic or sports. It's about being a good human. Erin will reach out to parents to help with donations for the monetary awards for this.
- d. Entrepreneurship Award- We will need to outline criteria. Erin will reach out to businesses to solicit donations.
