SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION: Phillip Oh Scholarship

The Philip Ki Joon Oh Scholarship recognizes three students on an annual basis who achieve above average marks in academics while demonstrating leadership qualities along with participation in sports, teamwork, community, volunteerism and are good “all-round” citizens.

Each Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$2,000.00.

ELIGIBILITY:

Level I - The applicant must:

- Be a Grade 12 student with an **academic average of 80% or higher** as of the application deadline of May 8, 2026 of the student’s grade 12 year
- Be an active participant on school and/or community sports team(s)
- Exhibit leadership and public speaking skills
- Be a volunteer and be active in community service
- Be accepted into first year of full time attendance at a post-secondary institution (university, college, or technical school) for a minimum of a two year diploma program

Level II - The applicant must:

- Be a Grade 12 student with an academic average of 70 – 79% as of the application deadline of May 8, 2026 of the student’s grade 12 year
- Contribute to the school and community through involvement in extracurricular activities by demonstrating participation in local service clubs, organizations, community activities, etc.
- Exhibit leadership and public speaking skills
- Be accepted into first year of full time attendance at a post-secondary institution (university, college, or technical school) for a minimum of a two year diploma program

Level III - The applicant must:

- For a student who demonstrates academic rigour across all subject areas and achieves strong academic success and passion in pursuing their vocation or trade-focused area of study

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION: May 8, 2026

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Complete, sign and date the attached application form.
2. Provide the names of two (2) references – one from the school and one from outside the school, neither of whom is a member of the Selection Committee.
3. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to an interview with the Awards Committee. This session is designed to provide the Committee with a comprehensive understanding of the applicant’s qualifications, achievements, and potential for impact.

SELECTION PROCESS:

ESBCHS Awards Committee (Assistant Principal, three (3) staff members and a member for Beaumont council); may be reviewed by the Philip Ki Joon Oh Scholarship Foundation upon request.
