- Smart carts and track for Science 10. Asking for \$1700 total.
- Folding tables and cart (for final exams). We are currently borrowing from other schools. Asking for \$3150.
- Matilda the Musical is asking for either \$4000 for techs to teach students the technical side of production. \$8000 would cover all set costs.
- Kiln for the art department. Old one is broken and can't be fixed. \$6945.75 for a new kiln.
- Poster printer to create school materials (monthly calenders, ads for sports and cultural events) and school work rather than doing printing elsewhere. Asking for \$5500.

c. Entrepreneurship Award will be moving forward for Grad 2027 - Dylan Dellezay will be taking it on with consultation and volunteers to raise the funds.
