- **Grade 12 students must request a minimum of 30 credits. \*If the total credits earned by the end of grade 11 is projected to be less than 75, you MUST choose 35 credits minimum (14 SCHEDULING BLOCKS).**
  - A full timetable consists of **16 SCHEDULING BLOCKS**. Grade 12's may choose **12-16 SCHEDULING BLOCKS**.
    - **3-credit courses count as one (1) scheduling block; 5-credit courses count as two (2) scheduling blocks & 10-credit courses count as four (4) scheduling blocks**
  - Instrumental Music & Musical Theatre are outside the timetable but **do count** as 2 scheduling blocks each.
