



ESBCHS Inreach Programming

ESBCHS needs the capacity to offer students some flexibility in course programming that we previously would have referred to the Outreach school. Due to block funding for students, courses can no longer be funded on a course-by-course basis.

Inreach programming will help to support students who:

- require course programming that cannot be accommodated in their timetable
- require flexibility due to being in a fragile state (ex. convalescence from injury, required hospitalization and/or supervised care, addiction recovery)
- may need support while on an extended leave of absence
- are registering at the school at atypical times of the school year
- have been removed from courses mid-stream and have an opportunity to salvage their course work in a non-attendance based format
- urgently required grad required courses
- require support in registering for Dual Credit course programming
- assist with credit recovery in certain circumstances
- have been referred to Inreach programming by school administration

Inreach programming will be:

- staffed with dedicated teaching time (approx. 0.250 FTE in total)
- non-attendance based
- administered out of student services for work-flow purposes (forms, tracking, reporting)
- Only accommodated within a traditional Sept-June school year
