MyPass reminder

All High School students should be getting registered on MyPass which allows you to see your course information and, ultimately, your diploma exam marks.

Alberta Education will send notifications in January however students can initiate the process themselves by going to MyPass.alberta.ca and following instructions but you must use an email address other than your blackgold address as it expires at the end of June.
