EF's Peace of Mind (Provided to all groups)

We know that plans can change due to unforeseen circumstances—that's why we provide the Peace of Mind Program automatically to all of our groups, so you can feel secure planning your next trip.

The cancellation policies outlined below take into consideration the costs EF incurs often years before groups ever depart. Notice of cancellation from an EF tour will only be accepted from the traveller, their legal guardian, or Group Leader. The date of cancellation is determined by the date on which EF receives notice. Cancellation refunds can only be made to the person whose name appears on the account; monies cannot be transferred to another account.

EF's Standard Cancellation Policy*

110 days or more prior to departure: Full refund less all non-refundable fees and a \$399 cancellation fee.


109 days to 45 days prior to departure: Full refund less all non-refundable fees and 50% of the program price.


44 days or less prior to departure: No refund will be issued.



Dear Students and Parents:

École Secondaire Beaumont Composite High School, in partnership with Education First (EF) Tours, is planning an educational trip to Switzerland, Italy, France and Spain. This ten-day trip will take place in July, with tentative dates of June 27 – July 7, 2024. These dates may fluctuate slightly, once we begin our registration process and the company secures flights. We will have one Black Gold Schools' employee (chaperone) for every eight students who register for the trip and will determine additional supervisors as the need arises.

This excursion is being offered to students in Grade 10, 11 and 12 during the 2023/2024 school year. Prior to the trip, these students will be enrolled in an online CTS Tourism Sector module and will earn 1 credit for this preparatory course. The intent of this educational component is to prepare students for international travel. This module may be completed online and our supervisors will be available to help students through this process. In addition, students will meet with supervisors on a regular basis through the school year and will also be expected to attend (with parents) evening meetings in preparation for travel. Some of the topics of these meetings will include: safety, traveling in groups, legal issues, currencies, customs and immigration, dealing with emergencies, as well as the importance of respecting the customs and traditions abroad. Dates of both student and parent meetings will be confirmed once the registration process is complete.

The cost of the tour is \$4939.00 and all payments will be made through our EF Tours travel website. This cost includes the following: international airfare, motor coach transport, accommodations, breakfasts and dinners, Travel Insurance, Tour Guides and/or translators, gratuities for bus drivers and guides, and admission to and/or guided tours of: Palais des Papes, Pont du Gard, Nimes Amphitheatre, and Flomenco Evening. \$26 of this fee is for a contingency fund for the trip. Any contingency funds not used on the trip will either be used for students in a follow-up event or will be refunded.

Approva

While we appreciate that many students may wish to attend this tour, there is an approval process prior to registration. For initial consideration, students must complete and return the attached Europe 2024 Code of Conduct for Students as well as the Europe 2024 Staff Endorsement and Europe 2024 Student Application (all are attached). In applying for the trip, all applicants and their guardians agree to abide by the conditions and expectations of our EF Tours, group leaders, school division and school community. As there will be a maximum of 36 students accepted for the trip we recommend the package to be handed in to the office as soon as possible. The deadline to apply for the Europe 2024 trip is October 6, 2023. If more than 36 approved applications are handed in before the deadline, acceptance will be on a first come first served basis.


Once approved, students will then receive an email with registration information on Friday, October 13. As all payment is made through the EF website, it is important to recognize that there is a non-refundable deposit of \$200 at the time of registration. Please read the Booking Conditions carefully.

Once registered, students must also be prepared to produce a valid Canadian Passport that is valid until at least January 31, 2024 (passports must be valid for at least six months beyond the
