## PLEASE READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION BEFORE COMPLETING COURSE PLANNER

- Grade 10 Students must be enrolled in a **minimum of 40 credits (not including Summer School courses)**.
  - A full timetable consists of **16 SCHEDULING BLOCKS**.
    - All **5-credit courses** (core or complementary) count as **two (2) scheduling blocks**
    - All **3-credit courses** (core or complementary) count as **one (1) scheduling block**.
  - Choose Complementary Courses on other side to reach a full course load. Tally credits & scheduling blocks on page 1 and carry over to page 2.
    - Instrumental Music runs outside the timetable and does not count for scheduling blocks but credits do count.
- \* French Immersion classes marked with \* may not run if enrolment numbers are too low.**
